



Competition Guidelines

Competitions are conducted under the current version of international wrestling rules as published by UWW (United World Wrestling) (See Annex 1)

Eligibility for endorsement

For a competition to be endorsed by Wrestling Australia Inc, the competition must be

- Conducted in accordance with the current UWW competition rules and regulations
- Conducted in accordance with the WA Inc policies including the Safer Clubs Program, and these guidelines
- All competitors must be financial registered members of WA Inc or affiliated State Association, have paid the appropriate entry fee, and completed a waiver

Endorsement Process

A club/State Association wishing to host a competition shall:

- Complete the application for WA Inc endorsement of a competition prior to the event and send it to the WA Inc National Office.

Event Type	Application required
Interclub event	21 days prior to event
State Championship	1 month prior to event
National Championship	6 months prior to event
International Competition	12 months prior to event

- **14 days prior** to the event the following forms should be completed and returned to the National Office;
 - Checklist for conducting a competition
 - Pre event Safety Audit
- **After the event** – Forward signed waivers to National Office
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Once WA Inc has received the information and the Host organisation has met all of the conditions, WA Inc will licence the host organisation to conduct the competition. A license will be sent to the Tournament Manager 7 days before the event. This license should be prominently displayed at the competition
